



FEST Film Law Terms and Conditions

1. By registering for the Film and Audiovisual Law Conference you accept the terms and conditions applied to the service. It is the responsibility of the user to analyse all the information published here before proceeding with the registration. The organization reserves the right to change the terms and conditions. These changes will be published on the official website and will be considered valid from that moment onwards.
2. No booking will be considered valid until FEST – AC receives the total value of the registration.
3. If there is the need of any major alteration of the event, due to force majeure circumstances, the registration is valid for the new dates. If the participant desires to be refunded due to a major date change due to force majeure circumstances, it must be requested no later than 10 days after the date change communication. In no case there will be reimbursement of any travel or accommodation expenses to participants due to force majeure changes.
4. The registrations cannot be re-utilized or returned, unless in case of cancelation of the session, yet if it is possible and reasonable, the name of the registration can be changed for another person to attend the session.
5. FEST – AC will not be responsible for travel expenses, or any other additional expense, in case of cancelation.
6. FEST – AC is not responsible for any compensation or refund in case of absence of the event by the participant for any “force majeure” (ie: situations out of the sphere of control of FEST – AC, such as war or threat of war; riots; civil unrest; industrial dispute; airport shutdowns; flight cancelations; terrorist activity; natural disaster; nuclear disaster; fire, adverse weather conditions; or similar situations)
7. There won't be any compensations or refunds in case of absence by the participant for professional, personal or health reasons.
8. The registration will be considered invalid in case of illicit resale.
9. The participants are responsible for checking the veracity of the information during the registration and report any errors or mistakes as soon as possible.



10. FEST – AC reserves the right to refuse entry and reimbursements in case of abusive behaviour, physical and psychological threats, drunk or disrespectful attitude. The same is applied in case the participant tries to enter the event with any object considered as a weapon or with any illegal substance.
11. FEST – AC will not be considered responsible for the loss or destruction of private property of the participant, nor will it be responsible for any medical or hospital expenses in case of injury or illness inflicted during the event nor on its installations or in the city that is hosting the event. For this exact reason the organization advises the participants to acquire health and travel insurance against all possible risks.
12. Clintons is a promoting partner of the Film and Audiovisual Law Conference. All obligations relating to the organisation of the conference and contractual or other relationship with attendees are with FEST – AC. Clintons shall have no responsibility for those aspects of the conference.
